A fall in global schooling and learning has been registered. Around **7 million** could leave school due to reduction in income.

Loss of learning due to various factors:

availability of resources, emotional overload, capacity to sustain interest, household responsibilities, **inability to cope with self-study strategies**, teacher preparation for virtual education.

An absence from the educational system for 7 months can result in a loss of

\$25.000
in the life of a student.
(World Bank-157 countries surveyed)

Girls are most vulnerable during school closures: less study time and more exposure to gender-based violence increases as access to educational services reduces. (UNESCO 2020)
