 - Share your culture by organising an event or online presentation with Global Lounge or lead a Language Café table.








 Our teachers are supported by the Bristol Institute for Learning and Teaching.


Taking a stand on climate change

Facilities

- Outstanding discipline-specific facilities such as the Life Sciences Building, with its five-storey laboratory wing, a state-of-the-art greenhouse and one of the largest teaching labs in the UK

- Three managed study centres including Beacon House, which features a collaborative study space and group working rooms

- Topics include cancer biology, infection and immunity, general neuroscience, and pharmacology.
- Class sizes are typically small.
